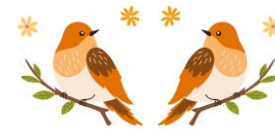

## End of Year Assessment

The end of cycle exams is ongoing this month and continue through to the beginning of June. It is extremely important that students are not absent during scheduled exam days in April, May and June. Please find below the scheduled exam days for the months of April, May and June.

**April 13-24:** Grade 4 FSL Exam (School Board)  
Grade 6 FSL Exam (School Board)

**May 19-22:** Grade 6 ELA MEQ Exam (Ministry)

**May 19-28:** Grade 4 ELA Exam (School Board)

**June 9-11:** Grade 4 Math Exam (School Board)

**June 11-13:** Grade 6 Math MEQ Exam (Ministry)

Grade 6 exams are mandated by the government (MEQ). They cannot be retaken. All other exams are mandated by the School Board. Do not schedule a vacation during SCHEDULED exam days in April, May and June. Please note that some exams are scheduled over many classes. It does not mean that there is an evaluation every day. The evaluations follow the regular schedule of the students. There are evaluations throughout the term that may not be included in the schedule.

Term 3 is worth 60% of the final grade in all subjects. Many evaluations take place throughout this term. **Attendance is highly recommended for academic success.**
